

# chi ha paura...?

During the Vicenzaoro - the leading gold & jewelry fair of Europa in Vicenza (Italy) - the complete Chi ha paura ...? collection is exhibited from the 21th of May until the 21th of June. Under the title 'Chi ha paura...? - Who's afraid of ...?' all 91 items can be seen in three sea containers, placed in the middle of the city centre of Vicenza. The three sea containers are installed in a street that connects the main shopping street with the Palazzo del' Erbe, where the Palladio Palazzo is situated. The installation is designed by the Milan - based architect Marco Romanelli. The elegant showcases, illuminated by LED, are especially developed for the exhibition and are equally placed on both sides of the containers. The exhibition is freely accessible for the public during the opening hours of the shops.



The initiator and organizer of the exhibition was Alba Cappellieri, who is the professor of jewelry design at Politecnico di Milano. Cappallieri has written the introduction text for the accompanying catalogue. The catalogue contains 91 full color pictures of all the CHP items and is published by Mondadio Elect, S.p.A., Milan.
